- A new sermon series will coincide with the new Sunday School curriculum in September.

This is what we've been preparing for! We're at the beginning of the season that lasts until next summer. Just like those amazing Olympic athletes, we've worked and prepared, and the time is here. Let's rev up and get the party started!



Creeds and Confessions—Month 3

During our summer Sunday school class, we had a session in which we learned about the PC(USA)'s creeds and confessions. Some 25 years ago, women of our church made beautiful, intricate banners to represent each creed and confession.

The Scots Confession (Scotland, 1560)

The blue of the shield is for the background color of the Church of Scotland. The tartan, x-shaped cross is in a form called the St. Andrew's Cross, he being the apostle who brought the gospel to Scotland. The tartan, or plaid, is that of the Hamilton clan in honor of the first martyr of the Scottish Reformation, Patrick Hamilton. The Celtic cross is another ancient form associated with the Christians of the British Isles. The ship is a symbol for the Church; the Scots Confession contains a remarkable, strong doctrine of the Church. The Bible and the sword represent when Paul called the word of God "The sword of the Spirit," and the sharpness of John Knox's preaching of the Word was a major power for reformation in Scotland. The burning bush which was not consumed reminds us of Moses' Sinai experience, thus a symbol of God's presence and call: the chief symbol of the Church of Scotland.

SESSION HIGHLIGHTS FROM AUGUST 19, 2024

Your session met on Monday, 8/19, 2024. Those in attendance shared joys and concerns. Ron Ray opened the meeting with prayer. Josh Hanley, chair of property, attended. The consent agenda was accepted into the record, including prior minutes, financial reports, and the meeting agenda.

<u>Property:</u> Josh Hanley and Ron Ray updated session on repairs: The aluminum gutters on the back of the educational wings will be painted, completing the roof work. Painting on the steeple will happen during September. Exteriors of windows have been cleaned. Two dead trees were removed from the property across the creek. Josh brought a discussion about future plans for the 1.83 acres of land on the other side of the creek. Session will consider the ideas and talk next month about moving forward.

<u>Adult Fellowship:</u> Mark Schnake, Tris Myers, and Susan Atkins have received Evelyn Bedell awards and will be honored at the Presbytery meeting on 8/27, and at a future worship service.

Adult Education: Pastor Susan explored options for a new Bible study.

<u>Children's Ministry</u>: Whitney reported that teacher training will be 8/25. There is new curriculum. All new volunteers must go through child protection training. Second grade Bibles will be given to five students in the 9/29 worship service. Sunday School resumes 9/1. Kids for Christ starts 9/4.

<u>Deacons</u>: The Deacons continue visiting members in nursing homes, sending cards, and providing meals.

<u>Local Mission</u>: Elaine reported the committee gifted new teachers with donuts and juice. The committee also helped the Mission to Mexico group by providing cookies for meals. They are providing Handi-Shop treats for workers in July and August. \$803 was collected on Baby Bundle Sunday.

<u>Music and Worship</u>: Josh reported the committee is updating the wedding policy to reflect current practices. The choir will begin singing again on 9/8.

Outreach: Micah reported the committee will host a booth at the Soybean Festival.

<u>Presbyterian Women</u>: Elaine reported circles will start meeting in the fall with new study guides.

<u>Staff</u>: The committee's motion to hire our new custodian was passed.

Stewardship & Finance: Robby gave a positive report on our finances, & plans for our stewardship drive in the fall are ongoing.

<u>Trustees</u>: The trustee financial report was received.

Youth and Young Adult: Andrew and Micah reported that youth group starts 9/1 and confirmation starts 9/8.

<u>New Business</u>: Session approved a payment to Leaderwise for the candidate and church portions of the CRE psychological evaluation. The September session meeting was moved to 9/23 at 6 PM.

<u>Clerk's Report</u>: Dianne reported the dates communion was served at church, at King's Daughters, and for a homebound person and family. Four baptisms were reported as well as three deaths.

The meeting closed with a devotion and prayer from Andrew Cauthorn and the meeting was adjourned.




