You've probably heard the expression, "The more things change, the more things stay the same." Right now there's a lot of change happening at our church! Things are getting replaced and renewed. Maybe you've driven by and seen the work being done on the steeple and roof, and maybe the shiny copper on the steeple surprised you. Did you know the steeple has always been copper?

Property Committee member Ron Ray explains that the original design plans called for copper clad construction of the steeple back in 1967, with it to immediately to be painted white, as noted in original architectural drawings. We will have a contractor follow the copper craftsman and return it to white. The spire is and will still be a weathered copper, although it may take several months to weather back to its patina. Things will be new on the inside, but on the outside it'll look the same.

There are other building changes that are visible to some people more than to others. The Kiddie Cushion on the playground might not mean much to the regular passer-by, but it'll sure make a difference to the children when they come off the slides. The Blessing Box was just painted and looks remarkably different but will serve the same purpose – just a little better.

As people, we're not much different than buildings. We may have huge changes on the inside, but since we look the same on the outside, no one realizes the change. We all change over time, and perhaps you're very different inwardly than you were a few years or decades ago, but your outward look remains the same. Like our church building, we might look the same while being deeply different underneath. People may not realize how much work has gone into creating the person you are today.

Do we recognize that others can change inwardly, as well? We might harbor resentment for who people were in the past, but they're not that person anymore even though they look and sound the same.

Sometimes big, visible changes are not necessarily the best idea. If we had completely changed the color of the roof to something totally different – say, terra cotta, with a bright red steeple – there would be an uproar not just in this church, but in

the community. There are people who see us as the landmark as sort of the start of town on the south side. We're a beacon as people come into town, and how we look matters.

In the end, the changes we're making (that won't necessarily look very different) are good for the church. May the changes you make within yourself be guided by your desire to be more like Christ, and may you be willing and eager to accept unseen changes in those you meet along the way.

SESSION HIGHLIGHTS FROM MAY 20, 2024

The Session of First Presbyterian Church, Mexico, Missouri met on Monday, May 20, 2024. Elders shared joys and concerns and the moderator opened the meeting with prayer.

The consent agenda was accepted into the record, including prior minutes, financial reports, and the meeting agenda. Stephanie Robinett was unanimously voted as clerk for this meeting.

<u>Adult Fellowship:</u> Whitney reported that the annual church BBQ will be on August 4, beginning at 10:30 AM. The committee is exploring new activity ideas. They are also working on Evelyn Bedell Award nominations and welcome ideas for that award. <u>Adult Education:</u> Mike Briggs shared that adult classes will be on a summer break and Pastor Susan will be leading a six-week summer course.

<u>Children's Ministry:</u> KFC has finished for the school year. 6 children will be attending Try-It Camp and 2 youth will go to canoe camp. <u>Columbarium</u>: Andy reported that the columbarium was cleaned and the bricks were resealed.

<u>Local Mission</u>: Elaine reported that baby Bundle Sunday raised \$603. The June Moment for Mission speaker will be Jody Dishman. <u>Music and Worship</u>: Josh reported that the committee has traditionally given a gift to families upon baptism of babies, but is exploring options for gifts for people of all ages who are baptized. They're also working on decisions about offering collection procedures.

<u>Outreach:</u> Micah reported that the livestream is going well. The committee is sending cards to people who worship with us online. <u>Presbyterian Women:</u> Elaine reported that the annual luncheon went well. Eunice Schnarre was recognized as the Lifetime Member. <u>Property:</u> Ron reported that the steeple and roof are currently being worked on. Volunteers are being organized for lawn maintenance throughout the summer.

<u>Scholarship:</u> The committee reported that two scholarships were awarded. The committee made the motion to raise the amounts we award. The motion passed unanimously.

<u>Staff & Administration</u>: Andy reported that the committee agreed to terminate the employment of our custodian, Ryan Totten on May 15th with pay through May 31. Session unanimously approved the committee's action.

<u>Stephen Ministries:</u> Mike reported on the group's work, and that they're starting a new book study with *The Anxious Generation*. <u>Technology:</u> Sound Solutions and Rob Dalton will be working on mic'ing the organ pipes so they can be heard in online broadcasts. <u>Youth and Young Adult</u>: Micah reported that 10youth will be attending the mission trip to Moberly. Triennium dates have been set. <u>Visioning:</u> An update on progress toward recommended goals from Visioning was received.

<u>Clerk's Report</u>: Stephanie reported that Sacrament of the Lord's Supper was served on May 5, 2024 in worship and at the Kings Daughters Home by the pastor. On April 28, 2024, we welcomed Shyanne Fagan into membership by baptism and Jan Harlow was also baptized. On May 12, 2024 April Leeann Dawn Jones, daughter of Ashlie Kare Crawford was baptized during worship. Donald George Linss and Sharon Sue (Howard) Kossman were received into membership on April 21, 2024, during worship.

Baptism of Carter Sue Cauthorn on June 2 and Ely Toellner, Everett Toellner, Ollie Toellner, and Lyle Toellner (on a date to be determined) were unanimously approved.

The meeting closed with a devotion and prayer from Andy Baker and the meeting was adjourned.





The **Bible Buddies** program began in 2019. It is based on Educational Benchmarks developed by the Children's Ministry Committee—what children should know year by year in developing their understanding of the faith. The teaching task is carried out by a Bible Buddy assigned to each student. The Bible Buddy meets with the child on a regular basis to study for about 10 minutes per session. As the child reaches each benchmark, a sticker is placed on their certificate.

When all the benchmarks for a grade level have been completed, the certificate is framed and presented to the student. Come and see the children's progress wall, located in first wing! If you would like to know more about

Kids for Christ


On the last day of Kids for Christ, each child was given a piece of a paper quilt with a circle drawn in the middle. Come and see our completed quilt in Fellowship Hall.
